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Competition Venue

The 2018 Boccia NSW State Titles will be held 16 - 18 March at the Sydney Academy of Sport, Narrabeen, NSW.

Accommodation

Accommodation is available at the motel on the same site at the Sydney Academy of Sport.

A limited number of rooms have been reserved and are available on a first come/first serve basis. Preference will be given to those who are travelling from interstate or rural/regional NSW (outside of Sydney). Please indicate your preferences on the separate accommodation form in this pack.

If you will be staying onsite, Boccia NSW will send you an invoice for the accommodation charges. The invoice will also include your registration fees – please do not forward any payment until you have received the invoice. Payment will still need to be made by the deadline.

BNSW is charged a \$15 facility entry fee per day if you are a day visitor (ie not staying onsite). This is included in your registration fee.

Participant Medical and Consent Form

** Sport and Recreation require a medical and consent form from those participating in recreation activities or where special diets are required and provided for. These forms can be completed online. The information required includes medical conditions, food related allergies, special diets, medication and emergency contact details.

Refreshments

The Benchwarmers Café will be open in the Gymnasium, throughout the competition 9am – 2pm, for those wishing to buy refreshments

Eligibility

There will be 6 classifications of athletes eligible to play in the BNSW State Titles, based on functional ability. Athletes in the BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4 and BC5 classifications must meet the requirements as outlined in the BISFed Boccia Rules which will govern this competition.

Unclassified athletes will play with the EMU athletes. This classification is for those athletes who do not meet the BisFed requirements; it means Every Member Unclassified. However EMUs will have a physical disorder of limbs including neurological impairment affecting the CNS, locomotor dysfunction of Non-Cerebral origin such as muscular skeletal disorders and / or limb deformities.

Classification

We have asked the APC to provide classification at the State Titles. If this is available athletes who have never been classified or need to be reviewed will be seen. If you/your child need to be classified you must complete the Classification Request form. If you are unsure whether you/your child needs to be classified, please contact Ken Halliday at kenhalliday@bigpond.com or 02 9999 4675.

Individuals will be contacted with scheduled date/times if classification is available.

Governing Rules

At this stage, BISFed Boccia Rules 2017 V1 will govern the competition. The rules are available at <http://www.bisfed.com/>. Athletes will be notified if there are changes to these rules.

Competition Structure

Individual divisions of play: BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4, BC5 & EMU. Please note that classifications may be merged together depending on player entries for each classification.

The finishing position in all pools for each classification will be determined by the athlete that has won the most games.

However, if number of games won are the same, positions will be determined by the result of the game against other athlete. If necessary the results of the points for and against will be used to determine the positions. For more information refer to the BISFed Competition Manual 2017.

The number of athletes will be capped at 40 Throwers (ie BC1, BC2, BC4, BC5 & EMU) and 16 BC3

However ideally it will be

- 8 x BC1
- 16 x BC2
- 16 x BC3
- 16 x BC4/BC5/EMU

Classifications will be filled on a first come, first served basis with priority given to NSW athletes.

Registration Deadline
